27 thereof "applicant"**28** AMENDMENT NO. 9**29** On page 3, after line 11, insert the following:**30** "Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective when an
31 Act of the Louisiana Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the
32 implementation of the provisions of this Act becomes effective.

1 Section 3. The provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective
2 upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time
3 for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section
4 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved
5 by the legislature, the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on
6 the day following such approval."
