SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes May 19, 2022, as Schizencephaly Awareness Day in Louisiana

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To recognize Thursday, May 19, 2022, as Schizencephaly Awareness Day in Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, schizencephaly is an extremely rare developmental birth defect
4	characterized by abnormal slits, or clefts, in the cerebral hemispheres of the brain; and
5	WHEREAS, some babies with schizencephaly have clefts in both hemispheres of the
6	brain, otherwise called bilateral clefts, and these babies commonly have developmental
7	delays, delays in speech and language skills, and problems with brain-spinal cord
8	communication; and
9	WHEREAS, other babies with schizencephaly have clefts in only one side of the
10	body, otherwise called unilateral clefts, and these babies are often paralyzed on one side of
11	the body, but may have average to near-average intelligence; and
12	WHEREAS, individuals with schizencephaly may also have an abnormally small
13	head, cognitive delay and impairment, partial or complete paralysis, or poor muscle tone;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, most individuals with schizencephaly will experience seizures, and
16	some people with the condition may have an excessive accumulation of fluid in the brain
17	called hydrocephalus; and
18	WHEREAS, the prognosis for individuals with schizencephaly varies depending on
19	the size of the clefts and the extent of neurological disabilities; and
20	WHEREAS, in general, treatment for schizencephaly consists of physical therapy
21	and drugs to prevent seizures; and

1 WHEREAS, in cases of schizencephaly that are complicated by hydrocephalus, 2 treatment often consists of a surgically implanted tube, called a shunt, that is used to divert 3 fluid to another area of the body where it can be absorbed; and 4 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the House of Representatives to raise 5 awareness of the need to prevent or treat developmental brain defects such as 6 schizencephaly. 7 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 8 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Thursday, May 19, 2022, as Schizencephaly 9 Awareness Day in Louisiana and hereby calls upon all citizens of the state of Louisiana to 10 raise awareness about schizencephaly.
