2	To enact R.S. 11:710.1(A)(1)(d) and to repeal R.S. 11:710.1(A)(1)(d), relative to the
3	Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana; to provide for reemployment of retired
4	teachers; to provide for compensation during reemployment; to provide for costs; to
5	provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

1	(d)(i) The provisions of this Subparagraph apply to a retiree certified to teach
2	mathematics, science, English language arts, or special education, and any teacher's
3	aide, instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor, who is assigned
4	the professional activity of instructing students or who is conducting research at a
5	public postsecondary education institution covered by this Section who retired prior
6	to December 31, 2021. The provisions of Subparagraphs (a) and (c) of this
7	Paragraph do not apply to such a retiree.
8	(ii) A retiree, as defined in Item (i) of this Subparagraph, may be employed
9	in any position covered by this system, provided that his earnings in such
10	employment do not exceed fifty percent of his final average compensation during
11	any fiscal year. If actual earnings exceed this amount, the benefits payable to the
12	retiree shall be reduced by the amount in excess of fifty percent of his final average
13	compensation.
14	(iii) A retiree, as defined in Item (i) of this Subparagraph, employed in a full-
15	time position pursuant to this Subparagraph may prospectively exercise Option 2 as
16	provided in this Paragraph any time prior to or after reaching fifty percent of his final
17	average compensation. In such case, all employee contributions made in accordance
18	with Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph prior to the exercise of Option 2 shall be
19	refunded at that time. If a retiree has earned in excess of fifty percent of his final
20	average compensation prior to an election made pursuant to this Item, the employee
21	contributions eligible for refund or the benefits payable to the retiree shall be reduced
22	by said amount.

24	Section 2. R.S. 11:710.1(A)(1)(d) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
25	Section 3. The cost of this Act, if any, shall be funded with additional employer
26	contributions in compliance with Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana.
27	Section 4.(A) This Section and Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall become effective
28	on July 1, 2022.
29	(B) Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2025.

**Abstract:** For a period of three years, increases the amount certain retired teachers may earn while reemployed without a reduction of retirement benefits.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System of La. to be reemployed in a position covered by the system without a reduction of his retirement benefit if his earnings from such employment during a fiscal year do not exceed 25% of his final average compensation. If his earnings exceed this limit, <u>present law</u> authorizes him to choose a benefit reduction or to become a member of the system again and earn a supplemental benefit.

<u>Proposed law retains present law except to increase the earnings limit to 50% of the retiree's final average compensation for the following:</u>

- (1) A teacher certified in mathematics, science, English language arts, or special education.
- (2) Any of the following who is instructing students or conducting research at a public postsecondary education institution:
  - (a) A teacher's aide.
  - (b) An instructor.
  - (c) An assistant professor.
  - (d) An associate professor.
  - (e) A professor.

Proposed law is effective for three years; then present law is again effective.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that any cost of <u>proposed law</u> be funded with additional employer contributions in compliance with Art. X, Sec. 29(F) of the state constitution.

Proposed law becomes effective on July 1, 2022, and is repealed effective July 1, 2025.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Retirement</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Change teachers to whom <u>proposed law</u> is applicable <u>from</u> those who returned to active service prior to Dec. 31, 2021, to those who retired prior to that date.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Limit applicability of <u>proposed law</u> to specified persons.
