<u>Present law</u> provides definitions for "athlete", "athletic trainer", "board", "board-approved organization", "BOC", "CAATE", "educational institution", "emergency management", "general supervision", "physician", "physician", and "practice of prevention".

Proposed law adds definition for "athletic injury".

Proposed law includes proposed law term, "athletic injury", where applicable in present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 37:3302(intro. para.), (1), (2), (8), and (11); Adds R.S. 37:3302(13))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House
