Amendments proposed by Senator Boudreaux to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 455 by Senator Boudreaux

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "amend and reenact" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety
3 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

4 "R.S. 51:1361(3), 1362(A), the introductory paragraph of R.S. 51:1363, 1365, the
5 title of Chapter 12 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, and R.S.
6 44:4.1(B)(35), and to enact R.S."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 1, line 3, change "broadband" to "the office of broadband development and"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, at the end of line 4, after the semicolon ";" add the following:

11 "to provide for the functions and responsibilities of the office of broadband
12 development and connectivity; to provide for the termination date of the office;"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof
15 the following:

16 "R.S. 51:1361(3), 1362(A), the introductory paragraph of R.S. 51:1363, 1365, and
17 the title of Chapter 12 of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 are
18 hereby amended and reenacted and R.S."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 5

20 On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

21 "CHAPTER 12. THE OFFICE OF BROADBAND **DEVELOPMENT**
22 **AND CONNECTIVITY**
23 §1361. Definitions
24 When used in this Chapter:
25 * * *
26 (3) "Office" means the office of broadband **development** and connectivity.
27 * * *"

29 On page 1, line 9, change "broadband" to "broadband **development**"

30 AMENDMENT NO. 7

31 On page 1, line 11, change "broadband" to "broadband **development**"

32 AMENDMENT NO. 8

33 On page 1, line 12, change "broadband" to "broadband **development**"

1 disclose, or cause or permit to be disclosed, to any third person, private entity
2 or public body as defined by R.S. 44:1, any broadband availability data
3 provided in accordance with this Section. The office, including any private
4 entity or third-party consultant retained or employed pursuant to this Section,

6 availability data remains strictly confidential and is not disclosed to or seen,
7 used or obtained by any third person, private entity or public body as defined

9 C. The requirements of this Section shall terminate under any one of the
10 following conditions, whichever occurs first:

11 (1) Upon a determination by the office of broadband development and
12 connectivity that it is no longer necessary to compile a statewide parish by
13 parish broadband map identifying the locations and capability of broadband
14 service in the state.

15 (2) At midnight on December 31, 2026.

16 D. The office may promulgate rules necessary to carry out the provisions
17 of this Section in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative
18 Procedure Act."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 14

20 On page 2, line 27, change "2026" to "2028"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 15

22 On page 3, below line 12, add the following:

23 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
24 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
25 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
26 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
27 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
