A RESOLUTION

To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Adam Christopher Gaubert.

WHEREAS, Adam Christopher Gaubert was born on May 10, 1974; after graduating high school, he followed in his grandfather's footsteps by serving his country in the United States Army; his service included a combat tour in Somalia; and

WHEREAS, after completing his enlisted service, Mr. Gaubert joined the Louisiana National Guard and the United States Army Reserve and earned the rank of Sergeant First Class; he worked as a police officer for the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and joined the Louisiana State Police on August 19, 2002; and

WHEREAS, during his time as a state trooper, Adam worked tirelessly to ensure the safety of his community; as an officer in the Louisiana State Police Patrol Division, he patrolled the state highways maintaining public safety; he also worked as a detective for the Louisiana State Police Criminal Investigations Division; and

WHEREAS, Adam earned the rank of Master Trooper on August 19, 2017; he was honored numerous times throughout his career for his commitment to ensuring public safety; he received the Meritorious Service Ribbon during the aftermath of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, a professional excellence award in 2006, a unit citation for his valued performance as a patrol trooper for Troop A in 2017, and numerous other commendations from the public, his peers, and his supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Master Trooper Adam Gaubert was tragically killed in the line of duty during an ambush-style attack in Ascension Parish on October 9, 2021; he leaves to cherish his memory his sons, Hunter and Dylan Gaubert; parents, Michael and Joann Gaubert; sisters, Kim Foster and Alisha Gaubert; brother-in-law, Michael Foster; niece, Dorothy Foster; nephew, Warren Foster; and a host of relatives and friends; and
