## SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes May 10, 2022, as St. Charles Parish Day at the state capitol

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To recognize Tuesday, May 10, 2022, as St. Charles Parish Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, one of the nine parishes included in the New Orleans metropolitan area,
4	St. Charles Parish is nestled along the banks of the Mississippi River and is located
5	approximately twenty-five miles upriver from New Orleans; and
6	WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish is often referred to as part of the German coast
7	because of the large population of German-speaking farmers that settled in the area during
8	the 1700s and whose arrival had injected new life into the city of New Orleans; and
9	WHEREAS, Lac des Allemands, with its bounty of wild Lac des Allemands catfish,
10	is responsible for Des Allemands in St. Charles Parish being proclaimed as the "Catfish
11	Capital of the Universe"; and
12	WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish is rich in resources such as catfish, shrimp, crabs,
13	natural gas, and oil; and
14	WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish is home to fourteen energy, petrochemical, and
15	logistic terminals and facilities, and is an economic driver for the regional, state, and national
16	economy; and
17	WHEREAS, considered in terms of exports, St. Charles Parish is the largest parish
18	in the region as the parish accounts for nearly thirty percent of the total value of exports in
19	the region; and
20	WHEREAS, throughout the year, there are more than fifteen tourist attractions and
21	fifteen fairs and festivals in St. Charles Parish.
