12 "(3) If a party who has the right to explore for and produce minerals from depths below the base of the underground reservoir component of the storage facility 13 14 is prohibited from drilling through the storage facility under Paragraph (2) of this Subsection by the exercise of the right of eminent domain granted in this Section, 15 that prohibition shall terminate upon a finding by the commissioner, after notice and 16 hearing conducted in accordance with R.S. 30:1105(C), that the storage facility 17 18 operator abandoned all reasonable efforts to use, or cause others to use, the storage 19 facility prior to any use of the underground reservoir component of the storage facility for the storage of carbon dioxide." 20
