"§3991.1. Corporate partners; enrollment preferences and board membership A. The legislature finds and declares that:

(5) Encouraging and enhancing partnerships between state and federal government partners, which provide for public health and safety, defense, and critical infrastructure, and the state's public education systems is to the benefit of the state and its students.

C. For purposes of this Section, a corporate partner is <u>a federal, state</u>, parish, or <u>municipal entity</u>, <u>subdivision</u>, or <u>agency</u>, <u>including a public</u> <u>postsecondary education institution</u>, or any legal entity, whether for profit or not for profit, registered with the secretary of state, except a corporation identified in R.S. 18:1505.2(L)(3), that has, acting individually or as part of a consortium of corporations, donated one or more of the following to the school:
