A RESOLUTION

2	To commend Dominic Joseph Hornsby on earning the rank of Eagle Scout.
3	WHEREAS, it is most fitting to commend and celebrate the accomplishments of
4	Dominic Joseph Hornsby of Boy Scouts of America Troop 100 on the memorable and
5	historic occasion of his attainment of the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout; and
6	WHEREAS, Dominic Joseph Hornsby is a sophomore at Brother Martin High School
7	in New Orleans; he achieved the status of Eagle Scout on November 7, 2021; and
8	WHEREAS, the mission of the Boy Scouts of America, founded on February 8,
9	1910, and chartered by the United States Congress in 1916, is to prepare young people to
10	make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime by instilling in them the values of the
11	Scout Oath and Law; and
12	WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in Scouting, a Boy
13	Scout must fulfill all requirements of leadership, services, and outdoor skills and must earn
14	twenty-one merit badges which signify the mastery of Scouting skills, including Citizenship
15	in the Community, Citizenship in the Nation, and Citizenship in the World; and
16	WHEREAS, Dominic faithfully embodies the twelve points of the Scout Law: he
17	is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave,
18	clean, and reverent; and
19	WHEREAS, Dominic is truly an exceptional Scout who is dedicated to the mission
20	of the Boy Scouts of America; he earned forty merit badges prior to becoming an Eagle

1 Scout, which is nineteen more than the minimum requirement to earn the highest ranking; 2 and 3 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout Project, Dominic installed a "little library" on the 4 grounds of St. Gabriel the Archangel Catholic Church; the installation holds free books for 5 children and adults to take and read; and 6 WHEREAS, presented with his Eagle Scout badge, Dominic Joseph Hornsby joins 7 the ranks of such esteemed and respected Eagle Scouts as the Honorable Gerald R. Ford, the 8 thirty-eighth president of the United States; Captain James Lovell, the commander of the 9 Apollo 13 space flight; Neil Armstrong, the first man to walk on the moon; acclaimed 10 filmmaker Steven Spielberg; and Bill Gates, the founder of Microsoft; and 11 WHEREAS, the legacy for the Boy Scouts is indeed a rich one, for it not only 12 includes a history of service of proud citizenship which spans more than a century, but it also 13 includes the history of service and singular accomplishments of Dominic Joseph Hornsby, 14 a young man to be recognized and commended by future Eagle Scouts and his community 15 for the deep human values and genuine spirit of good fellowship that he inspires. 16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Dominic Joseph Hornsby on the historic 18 occasion of his attainment of the rank of Eagle Scout; does hereby express utmost gratitude 19 and respect for the exemplary strides he has taken as a Scout and a citizen; does hereby 20 congratulate Dominic and the members and leaders of Troop 100 as they commemorate the 21 significant event of Mr. Hornsby's pledge of eternal loyalty to the code of the Eagle Scout; 22 and does hereby extend best wishes to Dominic Joseph Hornsby for full measures of 23 happiness and success in all of his future endeavors. 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to 25 Dominic Joseph Hornsby.
