Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 388 by Senator Hewitt

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 2, at the end of line 28, insert the following:
- 3 "<u>"Abortion-inducing drug" shall not include the sale, use, prescription, or</u>
 4 administration of a contraceptive measure, drug, or chemical if it is
 5 administered prior to the time when a pregnancy could be determined through
 6 conventional medical testing and if the contraceptive measure is sold, used,
 7 prescribed, or administered in accordance with manufacturer instructions."
- 8 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 9 On page 3, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

10"(6) "Woman" means a pregnant female whether she is a minor or of11the age of majority."

- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 13 On page 4, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

14	"(5) Any act by a licensed pharmacist or pharmacy related to filling a
15	prescription for a drug, medicine, or other substance prescribed for a bona fide
16	medical reason shall not subject the pharmacist or the pharmacy to the criminal
17	consequences if a diagnosis or a diagnosis code is written on the prescription by
18	the prescriber indicating that the drug, medicine, or other substance is intended
19	for a purpose other than to cause an abortion in violation of this Section."

- 21 On page 4, delete lines 18 through 22 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 22 "meaning and exclusions as provided in R.S. 14:32.9."

On page 4, at the beginning of line 26, change "<u>D. The Department of Health</u>" to "<u>D.(1)</u> <u>The Louisiana Department of Health</u>"

- 26 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 27 On page 4, after line 29, add the following:

28 "(2) A physician or other healthcare provider who is licensed to 29 prescribe medications or drugs that are subject to the provisions of Paragraph 30 (1) of this Subsection shall write a diagnosis or a diagnosis code on the 31 prescription that clearly indicates that the prescription is not intended to cause 32 an abortion in violation of this Section."

- 34 On page 5, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:
