A RESOLUTION

2	To recognize Tuesday, May 31, 2022, as Louisiana Music Advocacy Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, music and its creators are among Louisiana's greatest natural and
4	renewable resources; and
5	WHEREAS, Louisiana is the birthplace of so many of the world's musical styles,
6	such as jazz, blues, zydeco, swamp pop, rock & roll, gospel, country, bounce, rhythm &
7	blues, and Cajun music; and
8	WHEREAS, Louisiana's musicians, including many Grammy nominees and winners,
9	create an environment conducive to continued innovation in music; and
10	WHEREAS, the music industry in Louisiana is an economic driver which contributes
11	\$1.2 billion to the state's GDP and employs more than 30,000 Louisiana citizens yet has not
12	been fully recognized as a true industry akin to food, tourism, agriculture, manufacturing,
13	and others; and
14	WHEREAS, in a state where tourism is one of the largest industries, music is
15	regarded as one of the primary attractions enticing visitors to come to Louisiana; and
16	WHEREAS, Louisiana has numerous postsecondary educational programs devoted
17	to educating future musicians and music industry professionals; and
18	WHEREAS, it is essential that Louisiana recognize the economic importance of
19	Louisiana's music industry and incentivize growth of the industry's support system so as to
20	nurture careers in the music industry.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
