HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Representative Miguez to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 143 by Senator Morris

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 6 in its entirety and at the beginning of line 7, delete "course;" and
3 insert "relative to an online education course;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 8, after "readings;" and before "and" insert "to provide for promulgation of
6 rules;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 4, line 12, after "a" and before "online" change "sixty-minute" to "two-hour"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 4, between lines 13 and 14 insert the following:

11 **"B. The purpose of this online education course is to educate the public**
12 **on firearm safety and use. The course is optional and shall not be a requirement**
13 **for obtaining a concealed handgun permit under R.S. 40:1379.3. Completion of**
14 **this course shall not grant any person the right to carry a concealed handgun**
15 **unless otherwise provided by law."**

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 4, at the beginning of line 14, change "B." to "C."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 4, line 14, after "shall" and before "the following" change "cover" to "include
20 instruction on"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 7

22 On page 4, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

23 **"(5) Conflict resolution.**
24 **(6) Accident prevention.**
25 **(7) Unauthorized access prevention.**
26 **(8) Safe handling of a handgun."**

27 AMENDMENT NO. 8

28 On page 4, delete lines 20 through 22 in their entirety.

1 AMENDMENT NO. 9

2 On page 4, delete line 29 in its entirety and on page 5, delete lines 1 through 2 in their
3 entirety and insert the following:

4 "F.(1) The content, structure, accessibility, and all other related matters
5 of the online handgun education shall be developed and promulgated by the
6 Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police, in
7 accordance with the rules and regulations of the Administrative Procedure Act.

8 (2) In accordance with Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, the Department
9 of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police, shall divide the topics
10 provided in Subsection C of this Section into eight video segments that shall
11 broadcast for no less than fifteen minutes per segment."
