Boudreaux

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an insurer, managed care organization, or other payor shall not discriminate against an accredited durable medical equipment "DME" supplier providing services prescribed by a patient's physician. Further provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, an insurer, managed-care company, subcontractor, third-party administrator, or other payor shall reimburse DME suppliers no less than the state Medicaid rates set for these services on a continuous monthly payment basis for the duration of the medical need throughout a patient's valid prescription period.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
