Abstract: Provides relative to the right to vote.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that every citizen of the state has the right to register and vote upon reaching 18 years of age; provides exceptions.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> expressly limits this right to vote to U.S. citizens. Prohibits allowing noncitizens to register and vote.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Dec. 10, 2022.

- 1. Make technical changes to the ballot language.

The House Floor Amendments to the reengrossed bill:

- 1. Remove provision prohibiting local governments from changing voting qualifications as provided by <u>present constitution</u>.
- 2. Add prohibition on allowing noncitizens to register and vote.
- 3. Change the date for submission of the proposal to the voters <u>from</u> Nov. 8 to Dec. 10.
