1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
3 30:2418.1(C), (E), and (I)(1)(a)(i) and 2531.1(D)(1), (2), and (3) and to enact R.S.
4 30:2418(I)(5), relative to"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 5, after "tires;" insert "to provide for fees; to provide for the Waste Tire
7 Management Fund;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 7, change "R.S. 30:2418.1(C) and (E)" to "R.S. 30:2418.1(C), (E), and
10 (I)(1)(a)(i)"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, line 8, after "reenacted" insert "and R.S. 30:2418(I)(5) is hereby enacted"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, after line 19, insert:

15 "I.(1)(a) The fee on tires authorized to be levied pursuant to R.S.
16 30:2413(A)(8) shall not exceed the following:

17 (i) ~~Beginning October 1, 2018, through July 31, 2022, two~~ Two dollars and
18 twenty-five cents per passenger/light truck/small farm service tire. ~~Beginning on~~
19 ~~August 1, 2022, two dollars per passenger/light truck/small farm service tire.~~

21 (5) The secretary may authorize the use of monies in the Waste Tire
22 Management Dedicated Fund Account for the purpose of the emergency cleanup of
23 abandoned waste tires or an abandoned waste tire processing facility, if monies are
24 available after all payments have been disbursed in accordance with Paragraph (2)
25 of this Subsection. In no event shall monies from the account be used for this
26 purpose if the balance of the account is insufficient to meet the obligations owed to
27 waste tire processors provided for in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection.
