HOLIDAYS: Provides relative to legal holidays.

DIGEST

Present law provides for a list of legal holidays and days of public rest.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and removes Robert E. Lee Day, Confederate Memorial Day, and President George Washington's birthday as legal holidays. Adds President's Day as a legal holiday.

(Amends R.S. 1:55(A)(1) and (7), (B)(2), (D), and (E)(1)(a)(i))
