HOLIDAYS: Provides relative to legal holidays.

DIGEST

Present law provides for a list of legal holidays and days of public rest.

Proposed law retains present law and removes Robert E. Lee Day, Confederate Memorial Day, and President George Washington's birthday as legal holidays. Adds President's Day as a legal holiday.

(Amends R.S. 1:55(A)(1) and (7), (B)(2), (D), and (E)(1)(a)(i))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes.
2. Add and remove certain holidays from present law (R.S. 1:55(A)(7), (B)(2), (D), and (E)).

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to the reengrossed bill

1. Retains Huey P. Long Day, August 30th, as a legal holiday.
