1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 29:736(E), relative to state buildings; to exempt state buildings and facilities  
3 from locally declared disasters and emergencies; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 29:736(E) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §736. Exclusion

7 \* \* \*

8 E. Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter, no state building or other  
9 state immovable property is subject to any rule, procedure, guidance, restriction,  
10 prohibition, or limitation that stems from a declaration of a disaster or emergency  
11 declared by a parish president, mayor, or other local official.

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
14 by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
16 effective on the day following such approval.
