## HB 546 2022 Regular Session Mincey

HIGHER EDUCATION: Provides relative to the requirements for admission into a teacher education program and initial certification

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Remove <u>proposed law</u> making the standard aptitude test required for university admission an option for certification purposes.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides conditions for entry into a teacher preparation program at a postsecondary education institution, including meeting certain examination and grade point average requirements. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the examination requirement and retains all other entrance requirements provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides prerequisites for teacher certification, including passing an examination that includes English proficiency, pedagogical knowledge, and knowledge in the specialization area. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the English proficiency component and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
