4 WHEREAS, Lynwood J. Broussard married the former Marie Ann Comeaux and  
5 together they raised five children, three daughters and two sons, and have been blessed with  
6 four grandchildren, two granddaughters, and two grandsons; and

7 WHEREAS, a man of faith, Mr. Broussard is a parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic  
8 Church in Milton where he has been an usher for the past 64 years and is a former member  
9 of the St. Joseph Catholic Church Parish Council; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Broussard graduated from Youngsville High School in 1955 and  
11 proudly served in the Louisiana National Guard for six years; and

12 WHEREAS, Lynwood began his work career as supervisor of the Lafayette Parish  
13 Commodity Program for 10 years and subsequently served as manager of the Lafayette  
14 Parish Food Stamp Issuing Office for 28 years; and

16 Parish, and was sworn into office on May 25, 1972; he has officiated over 8,000 wedding  
17 ceremonies as of this date, and as a person who is always willing to help the people he
