| 9  | C.(1)(a) For the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school year years, a child, as a                 |
| 10 | prerequisite to enrollment in the first grade of a public school, shall have attended     |
| 11 | at least a full-day public or nonpublic kindergarten for a full school year, or shall     |
| 12 | have satisfactorily passed an academic readiness screening administered by the city       |
| 13 | parish, or other local public school board prior to the time of enrollment in the first   |
| 14 | grade. Each city, parish, or other local public school board shall establish the          |
| 15 | academic readiness level for entry into the first grade.                                  |
| 16 | (b) Beginning with the 2022-2023 2023-2024 school year, a child, as a                     |
| 17 | prerequisite to enrollment in the first grade of a public school, shall have attended     |
| 18 | a full-day public or nonpublic kindergarten for a full school year, and shall have        |
| 19 | satisfactorily passed an academic readiness screening administered by the city            |
| 20 | parish, or other local public school board prior to the time of enrollment in the firs    |

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
