<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission to promulgate rules and regulations to require companies taking menhaden by vessel equipped with purse seines to report monthly harvest, beginning May 2023. <u>Proposed</u> <u>law</u> requires the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to report the aggregated data and information from the menhaden harvest reports to the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment annually, beginning February 2024.
