HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 256

COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Metairie Park Country Day School French program and its students

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Metairie Park Country Day School students for their National French Awards  
3 2022.

4 WHEREAS, the American Association of Teachers of French sponsors the only  
5 nationally recognized French exam each year, *Le Grand Concours*; and

6 WHEREAS, the exam is particularly challenging because it involves listening,  
7 reading and writing; many participants are native French speakers or attend French  
8 immersion programs; and

9 WHEREAS, many of the Metairie Park Country Day students placed in the top three  
10 categories in their respective levels: bronze, indicating the student placed in the 75th-85th  
11 percentile in the nation; silver, indicating the student placed in the 85th-95th percentile in  
12 the nation; and gold, indicating the student placed in the 95th percentile or higher in the  
13 nation; and

14 WHEREAS, in French 2, students earning silver awards were Manish Jain, Mason  
15 Kwon, Max Pollock, Charlie Kazour, and Laney Hebert; Oliver Parsi earned a gold award;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, in French 3, Londyn Norwood was a bronze award winner; Pierce  
18 Hathaway and Minnie Mae August won silver; and Magdalena St. Louis, Winnie  
19 Goldenberg, and Bastien Sever won gold awards; and

1           WHEREAS, in French 4 there were two bronze winners, Clarisse Bernard Bitchatch  
2   and Raine Goldenberg; and four silver awards, Coco Goldenberg, Peetsie Goldenberg,  
3   Gabrielle White, and Mia Luparello; and

4           WHEREAS, all of these fine scholars are worthy of recognition for their hard work.

5           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
6   Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Metairie Park Country Day School students  
7   for their National French Awards 2022 and does hereby encourage all of the award winners  
8   to continue to strive for excellence.

9           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
10   principal of Metairie Park Country Day School.
