1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:85.1, relative to naming a gymnasium at Monterey High School; to
3 authorize the Concordia Parish School Board to name the new gymnasium at
4 Monterey High School in honor of Jack Bairnsfather; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 17:85.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 **§85.1. Naming of gymnasium at Monterey High School**

10 **The Concordia Parish School Board may name the new gymnasium at**
11 **Monterey High School in honor of Jack Bairnsfather.**

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16 effective on the day following such approval.
