## BY REPRESENTATIVE MINCEY

## AN ACT

To enact R.S. 17:154.1(C) and 1945.3 and to repeal Subpart H of Part III of Chapter 1 of Title 17, comprised of R.S. 17:341 through 348, relative to public school calendars; to require public school governing authorities to determine school calendars; to provide relative to the powers and duties of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state Department of Education with respect to school calendars; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 17:154.1(C) and 1945.3 are hereby enacted to read as follows: §154.1. Length of school day and year; requirements
C. Each public school governing authority shall determine the school-year calendar for the schools under its jurisdiction. Neither the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education nor the state Department of Education shall determine or $\underline{\text { require approval of a calendar for any city, parish, or other local public school board }}$ in the state.
§1945.3. Louisiana Schools for the Deaf and Visually Impaired; year-round operation; continuing service

The Louisiana Schools for the Deaf and Visually Impaired may operate yearround under the provisions of this Section, subject to the approval of the superintendent of the Special School District and subject to the availability of funds.
