2	To amend and reenact R.S. 15:590(7) and to enact R.S. 15:545(A)(3), relative to
3	fingerprinting persons arrested for operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated; to
4	provide for duties of law enforcement in every parish, municipality, and the state; to
5	provide for additional offenses that require fingerprint and identification data; and
6	to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 15:590(7) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 15:545(A)(3)
9	is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§545. Duty of law enforcement

13	(3) It shall be the duty of the sheriff of every parish, the chief of police of
14	each municipality, and every chief officer of every other law enforcement agency
15	operating within this state to record the fingerprints of all persons arrested for any
16	offense involving the operation of a vehicle while intoxicated, including local
17	ordinances pertaining to operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated. However,
18	there shall be no duty to record fingerprints if the fingerprint system at the local
19	prison is unavailable.
