2 On page 11, after line 24, add the following:

"Section 6. Notwithstanding Section 5 of this Act, if a final, unappealable judgment by a federal court in the cases of *Press Robinson, et al versus Kyle Ardoin, in his official capacity as Secretary of State for Louisiana* (U.S. District Court, Middle District of Louisiana, Civil Action 22-211-SDD-SDJ) consolidated with *Edward Galmon, Sr., et al versus Kyle Ardoin, in his official capacity as Secretary of State for Louisiana* (U.S. District Court, Middle District of Louisiana, Civil Action 22-214-SDD-SDJ) does not declare the congressional plan enacted by Act 5 of the 2022 1st Extraordinary Session of the Legislature to be in violation of Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, the following shall occur:

- (A) The provisions of Sections 1 through 5 of this Act shall cease to be effective.
- (B) R.S. 18:1276 as enacted by Act No. 5 of the 2022 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature and Sections 4 and 5(B) of that Act are hereby reenacted and shall become effective when the judgment in the cases is final and unappealable.
- (C) The provisions of this Section shall not reduce the term of a representative in the United States Congress."
