5	managers; to provide for appeals to the division of administrative law; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 37:1256(B) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 37:1256(C)
9	is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§1256. Louisiana Board of Pharmacy; authority to regulate pharmacy benefit
11	managers

13	B. A pharmacy benefit manager may be but is not required to shall be
14	permitted under Part IV of this Chapter if it administers, develops, maintains,
15	performs, or provides one or more pharmacy services in this state or that affects one
16	or more beneficiaries of a pharmacy benefit management plan administered by the
17	pharmacy benefit manager, as set forth in R.S. 40:2868.
18	C.(1) A pharmacy benefit manager may file for a hearing conducted
19	before an independent third-party adjudicator with the division of
20	administrative law upon notice from the board that it intends to take adverse
21	or disciplinary action against the pharmacy benefit manager that may result in

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1	the suspension or termination of the pharmacy benefit manager's permit. If the
2	pharmacy benefit manager elects to file for a hearing with the division of
3	administrative law, the ruling of the administrative law judge shall be
4	appealable by either the pharmacy benefit manager or the board, whichever
5	party does not prevail.
6	(2) Nothing in this Subsection shall be construed to prevent the
7	pharmacy benefit manager from proceeding with a hearing before the board as
8	provided for in the Administrative Procedure Act, nor shall anything in this
9	Subsection be construed to prevent the board from taking any other action
10	provided for by law or rule that would not result in suspension or termination
11	of the pharmacy benefit manager's permit.
12	Section 2. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 40:2868(A) is hereby amended and
13	reenacted and R.S. 40:2868(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

16	A. A pharmacy benefit manager may shall obtain and maintain a permit
17	from the Board of Pharmacy if the pharmacy benefit manager administers, develops,
18	maintains, performs, or provides one or more of the following pharmacy services in
19	this state or that affects one or more beneficiaries of a pharmacy benefit management
20	plan administered by the pharmacy benefit manager:

22	C.(1) A pharmacy benefit manager may file for a hearing conducted
23	before an independent third-party adjudicator with the division of
24	administrative law upon notice from the board that it intends to take adverse
25	or disciplinary action against the pharmacy benefit manager that may result in
26	the suspension or termination of the pharmacy benefit manager's permit. If the
27	pharmacy benefit manager elects to file for a hearing with the division of
28	administrative law, the ruling of the administrative law judge shall be
29	appealable by either the pharmacy benefit manager or the board, whichever
30	party does not prevail.

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1	(2) Nothing in this Subsection shall be construed to prevent the
2	pharmacy benefit manager from proceeding with a hearing before the board as

4	Subsection be construed to prevent the board from taking any other action
5	provided for by law or rule that would not result in suspension or termination
6	of the pharmacy benefit manager's permit.
