<u>Existing law</u> provides for the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Louisiana Public Defender Board and provides that the board may enter into contracts with various attorneys, local, state, and federal agencies.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further provides that the Louisiana Public Defender Board shall enter into a contract with the University of Louisiana at Monroe to provide training to certain attorneys, investigators, social workers, and staff. <u>New law</u> requires any contracts with the University of Louisiana at Monroe use existing funds appropriated by the legislature.
