Existing law provides that any person who is a patient of the state-sponsored medical marijuana program and possesses medical marijuana in a form permissible under <u>existing</u> law (R.S. 40:1046) for a qualifying condition, a caregiver, or any person who is a domiciliary parent of a minor child who possesses medical marijuana on behalf of his minor child in a form permissible under <u>existing law</u> for a qualifying condition pursuant to a legitimate medical marijuana prescription or recommendation issued by a physician licensed by and in good standing with the La. State Board of Medical Examiners shall be exempt from prosecution for certain violations of <u>existing law</u> (the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law).

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and adds that visiting qualifying patients shall also be exempt from prosecution for certain violations of <u>existing law</u> (the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law).

Effective August 1, 2022.
