<u>Existing law</u> provides that, upon conviction, a surety's obligation for a bail undertaking is relieved in any case, at any time prior to the defendant's failure to appear, by operation of law.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>existing law</u> does not prejudice the state's right to obtain a judgment of bond forfeiture under <u>prior law</u> after the lapse of 180 days following the execution of the certificate that notice of warrant for arrest was sent pursuant to <u>existing law</u>.

New law otherwise retains existing law.

Effective August 1, 2022.
