Deshotel

Existing law provides relative to qualifications of elected municipal chief of police.

<u>Prior law</u> required that an elected chief of police of a village be an elector of the village who at the time of qualification for the office had been domiciled for at least the immediately preceding six months in the village. Provided for exceptions.

<u>New law</u> provides that the police chief shall be a resident of the parish in which the village is located.

Existing law provides that a village is a municipality with a population of 1,000 or less.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 31, 2022).
