New law provides that no code, ordinance, land use restriction, or general or specific plan provision adopted by a parish or municipality may prohibit or have the effect of restricting a person's or entity's ability to use the services of a liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) provider who is capable and authorized to provide services at the person's or entity's property.

New law prohibits a parish or municipality from denying a permit application based on the LPG dealer's proposal to provide service to the project. Authorizes a parish or municipality to establish rules, ordinances, or requirements that do not supercede or conflict with existing federal or state laws, rules or regulations regarding the use or storage of LPG.

New law provides for prospective application only.

Effective August 1, 2022.
