<u>New law</u> provides definitions for "federal firearms licensee", "firearm", and "firearm hold agreement".

<u>New law</u> provides that no person shall have a cause of action against a federal firearms licensee operating lawfully in this state for any act or omission arising from or subsequent to a firearm hold agreement, including the return of any firearms to the individual firearm owner by the licensee, and resulting in personal injury or death of any natural person.

<u>New law</u> provides that the immunity from civil liability provided in <u>new law</u> shall not apply to any action arising from a firearm hold agreement if such action was the result of otherwise unlawful conduct on the part of the licensee.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>new law</u> shall not apply to firearm transfers pursuant to the Domestic Violence Prevention Firearm Transfer.
