<u>Existing law</u> provides conditions for entry into a teacher preparation program at a postsecondary education institution, including meeting certain grade point average requirements. <u>Prior law</u> included meeting certain examination requirements among these conditions. <u>New law</u> removes the examination requirement.

<u>Existing law</u> provides prerequisites for teacher certification, including passing an examination that includes pedagogical knowledge and knowledge in the specialization area. <u>Prior law</u> required that this examination also include English proficiency. <u>New law</u> removes English proficiency from the required exam components.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 18, 2022).
