Requests the La. Housing Corp. to perform all necessary studies and to hold public hearings for the purpose of soliciting comment on the following topics affecting the availability of low-income housing:

- (1) Protecting La.-based housing developers from business practices of some out-of-state investors, including removal of the developer from the partnership prior to completion of the compliance period and demanding substantial unanticipated cash contributions.
- (2) Strategies to expand affordable housing through low income housing tax credit program in parishes with a population of less than 250,000.
- (3) Strategies for expanding benefits and improving incentives for Louisiana-based housing developers.

Requests that the corporation report its findings to the House of Representatives prior to March 1, 2023.
