Bacala

Abstract: Provides that the crime of criminal trespass does not apply to any person operating a watercraft on running waters of the state.

Present law prohibits any person from entering upon, or remaining in or upon, immovable or movable property owned by another without express, legal, or implied authorization.

Present law further provides that such prohibition shall not apply to any person operating an unmanned aircraft system in compliance with federal law or Federal Aviation Administration regulations or authorization.

Proposed law retains present law and further provides that the present law prohibition shall also not apply to any person operating a watercraft on running waters of the state in accordance with present law (C.C. Art. 450, 452, 455, or 456).
