If the board establishes 8 additional tiers, it shall provide for the criteria for each tier and the associated 9 application process. 10 E. F. For purposes of this Section, "veteran" shall have the meaning as 11 provided in R.S. 13:5364.

**Abstract:** Authorizes the Bd. of Regents to establish additional tiers of recognition for institutions designated as military and veteran friendly campuses.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a program for designating a postsecondary education institution as a "Governor's Military and Veteran Friendly Campus". Provides for program administration by the Bd. of Regents and that this designation applies for one year. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the designation's duration <u>from</u> one year <u>to</u> two years.

<u>Present law</u> requires that an institution annually submit a renewal application to the board that contains certain information related to its services and accommodations for students who are veterans or serving in the military. <u>Proposed law</u> instead provides that the renewal application be submitted prior to expiration of the designation and also requires submission of a report in each interim year containing the same minimum information.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the board to establish additional tiers for further recognizing institutions that have received the designation.
