CULTURE/REC/TOUR DEPT: Provides relative to advertisement and sponsorship signs on property of the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 36:204(B)(11), relative to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism;
3 to authorize the secretary to enter sponsorship agreements and to authorize
4 placement of advertising and sponsorship signs on department property; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 36:204(B)(11) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §204. Powers and duties of secretary of culture, recreation and tourism

9 * * *

10 B. The secretary shall have authority to:

11 * * *

12 (11) Enter sponsorship agreements and to authorize the placement, erection,
13 and maintenance of advertising and sponsorship signs on immovable property,
14 improvements on immovable property, vehicles, vessels, and assets of the
15 department. The secretary shall promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with
16 the Administrative Procedure Act to implement the provisions of this Paragraph.
