Abstract: Provides relative to the designation of the marshal of the city court of Sulphur and the source of funding for certain marshals and constables.

Present law provides that a marshal or constable, except the marshal of the City Court of Lake Charles, may be designated for each city court.

Proposed law adds an exception for the marshal of the city of Sulphur and designates the marshal as the ward four marshal.

Present law provides for the payment of deputy marshal salaries exclusively by the local governing authority of the city or parish, or both, where the court is located.

Proposed law provides for the payment of deputy marshal salaries by the local governing authority of the city or parish, or both, where the court has territorial jurisdiction.

Present law provides that the marshals of city courts shall be paid by the governing authorities of the city and parish where the court is located.

Proposed law provides that the marshals of city courts shall be paid by the governing authorities of the city and parish where the court has territorial jurisdiction.
