1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 42:1160, relative to electronic documents; to provide for methods of response;

3 and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 42:1160 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§1160. Electronic response required**

7 **Any communication from the board in response to a report filed**

8 **electronically through the Computerized Data Management System as provided**

9 **for in this Subpart shall be sent to the filing party electronically in a timely**

10 **manner relative to any applicable deadlines.**
