STATE EMPLOYEE/LEAVE: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the establishment of uniform leave policies by law

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to add Article X, Section 31 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to provide relative
3	to leave policies for state employees; to authorize the legislature to adopt uniform
4	policies applicable to all state employers and employees; to provide for submission
5	of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related matters.
6	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
7	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
8	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add
9	Article X, Section 31 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
10	§31. Employee Leave Policies
11	Section 31. Notwithstanding any limitation on legislative authority otherwise
12	provided by this constitution, the legislature may enact employee leave policies that
13	provide minimum requirements which are uniformly applicable to all state
14	government employers and employees.
15	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
16	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on October 14,
17	2023.
18	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
19	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted

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Abstract: Authorizes the legislature to enact employee leave polices which are uniformly applicable to all state government employers and employees.

<u>Present constitution</u> creates the State Civil Service Commission and grants it broad and general rulemaking powers for the administration and regulation of the classified service for state employees, including the power to regulate employment, promotion, demotion, suspension, reduction in pay, removal, certification, qualifications, political activities, employment conditions, compensation and disbursements to employees, and other personnel matters and transactions. <u>Present constitution</u> further creates education management boards with authority to supervise and manage institutions and programs in their respective systems.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> authorizes the legislature to enact employee leave policies that provide minimum requirements which are uniformly applicable to all state government employers and employees.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 14, 2023.
