Abstract: Prohibits pedestrians from pulling or pushing carts on state highways.

<u>Present law</u> specifies that where sidewalks are not provided, any pedestrian walking along and upon a highway, when practicable, must walk only on the left side of the highway or its shoulder, facing traffic which may approach from the opposite direction.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds to <u>present law</u> that no pedestrian walking along a highway can push or pull a cart in proximity to open moving vehicular traffic that could render travel unsafe.
