TELEVISION/CABLE: Provides relative to franchise fee audits

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AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 45:1367(A), relative to franchise fee audits; to provide a limit on which records may be addressed in a review; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 45:1367(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1367. Franchise fee audits and dispute resolution

A. The local governmental subdivision, upon reasonable written request, may review the business records of a cable service provider or video service provider to the extent necessary to ensure payment of the franchise fee in accordance with R.S. 45:1366. Any review conducted in accordance with this Section shall not address any period more than three years before the date the review is commenced.

Abstract: Enacts a time limit on records that may be addressed in an audit.

Present law provides that a local governmental subdivision, upon reasonable written request, may review the business records of a cable service provider or video service provider to the extent necessary to ensure payment of the franchise fee in accordance with present law.

Proposed law amends present law and states that a review shall not address any records produced more than 3 years from the date the review is commenced.
