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Allows the Louisiana Historical Records Advisory Board to conduct meetings via electronic means. (gov sig)

Proposed law allows the Louisiana Historical Records Advisory Board to conduct meetings via electronic means. Proposed law requires the board to provide a physical anchor location from which the meeting shall originate and at which the presiding officer of the meeting shall conduct the meeting. Proposed law requires that a notice and agenda for the meeting must be posted on the Secretary of State website and emailed to any member of the public or news media upon request. Proposed law requires the board to provide and utilize a mechanism for the receipt of public comments. Effective upon governor's signature.
