Under current law, when a person who qualifies dies after the closing of qualifying but before the closing of the polls on the day of the election, qualifying is reopened the day after the death and closes the third day after the death. Proposed law changes the reopening period to the day after the Secretary of State (SOS) receives actual notice of the death.
