Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 226

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "1881(B)," delete the remainder of the line and insert  
3 "1883(A)(introductory paragraph) and (C), and 2583.1(C),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 6, after "Sulphur;" and before "and" insert "to provide relative to  
6 qualifications of deputy constables;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "1881(B)," delete the remainder of the line and insert  
9 "1883(A)(introductory paragraph) and (C), and 2583.1(C) are"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, line 22, after "court" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line  
12 23, delete "territorial jurisdiction" and insert "is located"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 3, line 6, after "court" delete the remainder of the line and insert "is located:"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 3, at the beginning of line 10, delete "has territorial jurisdiction" and insert "is  
17 located"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 3, after line 15, add the following:

20 "§2583.1. Deputies; oath; compensation

21 \* \* \*

22 C. The deputy constables authorized by this Section shall have the same  
23 qualifications and training as required by law of the constable of the justice of the  
24 peace court. The deputy constable need not be a resident of the ward from which the  
25 constable is elected, but he must be a resident of ~~the parish within which the ward~~  
26 is located this state.
