Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Original House Bill No. 250 by Representative Bishop

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 47:1907(L)" and before the comma "," insert "and (M)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, after "time;" and before "to provide" insert "to provide for certain
5 requirements and limitations; to require the publication of certain notice;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, delete lines 6 and 7 in their entirety

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, at the beginning of line 10, delete "is" and insert "and M are"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, line 13, after "H" and before "of this" delete the comma "," and delete "I, J, K,
12 and (L)" and insert "through (M)"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 2, line 8, after "exceed" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and delete
15 line 9 in its entirety and insert the following:

16 "two percent in calendar year 2023.

17 M.(1) In addition to all other forms of compensation which are authorized
18 for assessors under the provisions of this Section, an assessor may increase his
19 annual compensation once in an amount not to exceed eight percent during each
20 term. The increase in compensation authorized pursuant to the provisions of this
21 Subsection shall apply for each term beginning on or after January 1, 2025.

22 (2) The additional compensation authorized pursuant to the provisions of this
23 Subsection shall become effective thirty days after the one-time increase is disclosed
24 at a public meeting of the parish governing authority of the parish in which the
25 assessor's office is situated if the assessor publishes notice of his intent to increase
26 his compensation on two separate days in the official journal of the parish in which
27 the assessor's office is situated. The last day of publication of the notice shall be at
28 least thirty days prior to the public meeting of the parish governing authority wherein
29 the assessor discloses his intention to increase his compensation."
