HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides for visitation policies at certain healthcare facilities and requires that such policies allow for in-person visitation

Proposed law requires certain healthcare facilities to develop policies and procedures to allow in-person visitation for any of their residents, clients, or patients. The provisions may include review of infection control, hand washing, and education policies, requirements for temperature screening, review of safety procedures and any other infection control procedures.

Proposed law provides that the policies and procedures may not be more stringent than those established for the facility staff, and may not require visitors to submit proof of any vaccination or immunization. The policies and procedures allow consensual physical contact between a resident, client, or patient and his visitor.

Proposed law provides that an employee of the facility shall be designated as the responsible party for ensuring that the visitor adheres to the policies and procedures.

Proposed law requires a facility to submit a written copy of its visitation policies and procedures to the Health Standards Section of LDH when applying for initial licensure, licensure renewal, or change of ownership. In addition, LDH is required to dedicate a stand-alone page on its website to explain the visitation requirements and provide a link to the facility's webpage to report complaints.
